

Fruit Tree Program



Why consider a Fruit Tree Program?

The two main reasons for considering a Fruit Tree Program are as follows:

1. To reduce & control *insects* entering the fruit, as well as causing leaf damage.
2. To control *disease* from damaging both the leaves and fruit.

How many Applications are recommended throughout the growing season?

Our Fruit Tree Program consists of four applications per season. Weather conditions & insect activity, along with the type of tree we are treating, can affect the actual timing of the spray. Here's what a normal program may look like:

1. Delayed Dormant Oil + Copper Fungicide Spray: (Bud Break – Normally this can range from the end of March to the middle of April)
2. Insect & Disease Control: (This application is timed right after the bloom petals fall off the tree: Mid/End May)
3. Insect & Disease Control: (End May/1st Week of June)
4. Insect & Disease Control: (Mid/End June)

Can wormless fruit be completely guaranteed?

No. However, by monitoring both insect activities along with weather patterns, we can greatly reduce the amount of damage, if any, with only four applications.
